# **FAMILY SPIRITUAL PRACTICES**

- Sticky Prayers: Write simple prayers on address labels, sticky notes, or index cards, and stick them places family members will see often, such as on computers and water bottles. Prayers can be as simple as "God, show me where You are working," and "Holy Spirit, help me with \_\_\_\_\_." Repeating these simple prayers will help the whole family remember that God is with them and for them.
- Holy Spirit Assignments: As a family, come up with a Holy Spirit assignment—something each of you can do with the Holy Spirit's help, such as showing kindness to a neighbor or saying "Thank you" to a teacher or boss. At the end of the day, share how it went!



# **BREATH PRAYER**

A breath prayer is a word or phrase to repeat in a single breath with one part on the inhale and the other part on the exhale. Breath prayers help us focus on God and His presence with us. Try this together as a family.

Inhale: God, You are working ... Exhale: help me to see.
